



## Guide booster 2022-2023

Booster: subject targeted for students learning a new language following the common European framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR).

It helps develop their language skills starting with listening comprehension and speaking.

Students are identified by their homeroom teachers.

Following the completion of the booster course, students must have a linguistic level of:

- CP-CE2: at least A1
- CM1-5e: at least A2
- 4e-3e: at least B1

There are 2 booster levels (following the Common European Framework):

- Booster level 1: European framework A0-A1: beginner level.
- Booster level 2: European Framework A2: from the CM1 class, students should continue, depending on their rate of progress, if necessary, to follow booster reinforcement courses (higher level) in order to be able to better integrate English lessons for their class level.

\*for the 2022-2023 school year: Level 1 lessons are set up 3 times a week during the language lessons of their class. Level 2 lessons are set up twice after school time.

The students of the 2 levels are evaluated at a booster level on the language.

N.B. The booster course is offered for the 3 main languages taught at the establishment.

In Arabic, courses are offered for students enrolled in ALM (Arabic Mother Tongue) since the ALE (Arabic Foreign Language) course is an introduction to the language.
