



TO KEEP IN MIND, FROM THE START OF THE YEAR!

- Important last-step reminder to new students: Following local laws and regulations, students may only join the class once the official registration and signing of the KHDA 'Parent-School Contract' is fully completed. In case you doubt having completed this step, please verify with our KHDA coordinator, Sara Atat, compliance@icedubai.org.
- Plan your transportation.
- Label your children's belongings so that they come back to you in case they are misplaced. If needed please contact the student life or the 'objets perdus | Lost & found'
- **Textbooks and school supplies** are complete, in the school bag, inclusive of the iPad® which is dedicated to *learning only*, starting from grade 4 (details <u>page 5</u>). For the lists of supplies see <u>page 5</u>, or on the <u>website</u>, or our partner <u>Culture & Co</u>
- Hydration & Heat
 - Always provide a large reusable water bottle labeled with the child's name
 - Provide a cap (uniform's or white), also labeled with the child's name
- Snacks and meals
 - Have the snacks packed ready-to-eat and in the appropriate container.
 - Meals at home must be healthy, balanced, and in a container ('lunch-box') that is temperature-insulating, not leaking, and easy to open.
 - In Primary (only) dishes cannot be heated. Preheat them if necessary. Reheating is possible for the Secondary levels' restaurant only.
 - Register for the school canteen with our partner Ben's Farmhouse HERE
- Wearing the uniform is mandatory (see page 4).
- Familiarize yourself with the academic application PRONOTE® (contact for help: pa.principal@icedubai.org), and/or SEESAW in kindergarten (via the teachers).

- ATTENTION: students registered for the bus, in classes from KG2 (GS) to Gr. 9 (3ème):
 - No school bus service on the <u>morning</u> of the first day of the school year, but the return trip at the end of the day is assured, Monday 25 August.
 - o Return journeys from Tuesday 26 Aug. (not for Pre-K [PS] classes)
- Reminder: For safety reasons, it is forbidden to arbitrarily use another bus than the one for which you have registered.

Directly purchased devices will be delivered at the school start. This device is a school-work tool and as such, it is limited to restricted and controlled content. If you refuse, contact the student life to buy the printed textbooks.

Note: Exceptionally, iPad® for **GR. 4** (CM1), which are in their first year of school use, <u>can be configured at school during the first two weeks</u> of the start of the school year.

Note! Unconfigured iPads® will not be allowed, subject to confiscation.

iPad[®] (Apple product) exclusive pedagogical tool and constituent of school supplies for Grades 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10 and 11 (CM1 to 1ère)

iPad® pedagogical tool guidelines

Please refer to the updated **DIGITAL TOOL POLICY here**

1. Configuration

Students' tablets that have not been appropriately configured for learning and wellbeing by the school will not be accepted on the school premises.

The school's technical engineers will configure the iPad® as a pedagogical tool with all necessary applications and files for learning, which will not allow installation of a personal choice of applications from the family's or the student's Apple store.

Instead, a selection of approved pedagogical apps are available to install at school.

The storage will not be sharable with the family's Apple ID(s) as long as the iPad $^{\mathbb{R}}$ is used as the pedagogical tool.

Purchasing the iPad[®] from the school is optional. However, any iPad[®] provided by the family to become the pedagogical tool will have to be configured by the school's technical department. Please refer to the detailed information "3. Personal Device iPad Configuration – BYOD iPad[®]" on page 2.

2. Purchase orders through BFIS-ICE

2.1. Purchase: on or before August 09th, 2025, upon request to IT@icedubai.org

Ordered iPads® will be configured and then delivered to the child on the first day of school, or, may be collected by parents between August 19th-22nd, at a time coordinated with IT.

3. Personal Device iPad Configuration - BYOD (Bring Your Own Device)

Parents who wish to provide their own device (iPad® minimum 8th generation, 128GB storage) must book an appointment with the school's IT through the link: <u>iPad Configuration BookNow</u>

Kindly bring your device to school on or before August 22nd, 2025 to allow enough time for the configuration.

For students joining during the school year, please allow 5 working days for the configuration.

Price: AED 395.00 Included:

- Pedagogical tool configuration of the device
- Subscription to "Care for Personal Device iPad® Configuration" for two years
- Data restoration, including essential Apple System Manager software for the classroom

Kindly note the summary below before proceeding with bringing your own iPad®:

- 1. Service charge to configure your personal device 395 AED
- 2. Save the data on an external device or personal cloud.
- 3. Erase/remove iCloud account, personal pictures and information, all the added content and settings from the iPad®.
- 4. Bring the device to the Technical IT Department into its *initial settings* stage.
- 5. School Personal Device Configuration for the iPad will take 20 mins to 30 mins.
- 6. From then on, the school supervises the iPad and regularly installs required applications for education through MDM (LICENSE IPAD MDM Mobility Device Management, included).
- 7. The configuration includes:
 - 200GB of iCloud storage via school Apple ID.
 - Temporary iPad® replacement in case of failure for 10 days
 - Installation & Setup Licenses & all Educational Programs required
- 8. In case the device is misplaced or lost, the school may use the Location Finder to locate it.
